**THE SUPREME COURT (MASTERS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2014 MADE BY THE CHIEF JUSTICE WITH THE CONCURRENCE OF THE PRIME MINISTERS, PREMIERS AND CHIEF MINISTERS OF ALL THE STATES AND TERRITORIES IN EXERCISE OF THE POWER CONFERRED UNDER SECTION 12(1) OF THE SUPREME COURT ORDER 1967 (S.I. NO. 223 OF 1967).**

**1. Citation**

This Order may be cited as the Supreme Court (Masters) (Amendment) Order 2014.

**2. Commencement**

This Order is deemed to have come into force on the 1<sup>st</sup> day of June 2014.

**3. Interpretation**

In this Order, “**principal Order**” means the Supreme Court (Masters) Order 2008 (S.I. No. 4 of 2008).

**4. Amendment of section 5**

Section 5 of the principal Order is amended by deleting “three” and substituting “five”.

**5. Amendment of section 6**

The principal Order is amended by deleting section 6 and substituting the following—

“6. The number of Masters may be varied by Order of the Chief Justice, with the concurrence of the Prime Ministers, Premiers and Chief Minister of all the States and Territories.”.

**6. Amendment of section 21**

Section 21(1) of the principal Order is amended by deleting “territory” and substituting “Territory”.
