**PROCLAMATION MADE BY THE GOVERNOR UNDER SECTION 24 OF THE DISASTER PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE ACT (CAP. 10.03).**

**A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR**

**ELIZABETH CARRIERE**

**WHEREAS** under section 24(1)(a) of the Disaster Preparedness and Response Act (Cap. 10.03) the Governor may, on the advice of the Premier and after consultation with the Director for Disaster Preparedness and Response, declare by proclamation (S.R.O. 47 of 2017) dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of September, 2017 that there is a substantial prospect that a Hurricane may strike the Island; and that Hurricane has struck the Island;

**AND WHEREAS** the Governor has been further advised by the Premier, on consultation with the Director for Disaster Preparedness and Response, that the conditions on the Island have improved considerably since date of abovementioned Proclamation;

**NOW THEREFORE, I, ELIZABETH CARRIERE**, Governor hereby declare that Proclamation ( S.R.O 47 of 2017) dated the 4<sup>th</sup> day of September 2017 is repealed.

**AND** all Her Majesty's Officers and loving subjects in Montserrat, and all those whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice and conduct themselves accordingly.
