A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR

ELIZABETH CARRIERE

WHEREAS under section 24(1)(a) of the Disaster Preparedness and Response Act (Cap. 10.03) the Governor, on the advice of the Premier and after consultation with the Director for Disaster Preparedness and Response, declared by Proclamation (S.R.O. 49 of 2017) dated the 18th day of September 2017 that there is a substantial prospect that a Hurricane may strike the Island; and declared by Proclamation (S.R.O. 51 of 2017) dated 20th day of September 2017 that a Hurricane has struck the Island;

AND WHEREAS the Governor has been further advised by the Premier, on consultation with the Director for Disaster Preparedness and Response, that the conditions on the Island have improved considerably since the date of the abovementioned Proclamations;

NOW THEREFORE, I, ELIZABETH CARRIERE, Governor hereby declare that Proclamation (S.R.O. 49 of 2017) dated the 18th day of September 2017 and Proclamation (S.R.O. 51 of 2017) dated the 20th September 2017 are hereby repealed.

AND all Her Majesty's Officers and loving subjects in Montserrat, and all those whom it may concern are hereby required to take due notice and conduct themselves accordingly.
