



Seeking Expressions of Interest for New Board Members

The Info-Communications Authority of Montserrat is seeking Expressions of Interest (EOI) from people who are suitable and willing to be considered for appointment to our Board of Directors.

The Montserrat Info-Communications Authority (MICA) is the Regulatory Agency for the Government of Montserrat across the Telecommunications, Information and Communications Technology (ICT) and the Broadcasting industries. The Agency was established in 2009 to support the thrust to have the Info-Communications Sector serve as the main vehicle for the transformation of the island into an intelligent Island with the necessary and sufficient socio-economic infrastructure to accelerate and sustain growth and development of the economy.

Our strategic purpose is to:

- a) encourage competitive markets for info-communications networks and services
- b) facilitate the orderly development of an info-communications system
- c) promote and protect the interests of the public
- d) promote the info-communications industry in Montserrat
- e) ensure regulatory flexibility and technology neutrality
- f) facilitate competition and development for liberalizing the info-communications market
- g) regulate info-communications activities on the Island

The Authority is managed by a Board of Directors who provide governance and strategic leadership to the organisation and is comprised of people with a variety of skills and backgrounds to include training and experience, in an info-communications discipline and law. Director positions are voluntary; however, a modest stipend is provided each quarter. Board members' terms are not more than three years at any one time but may be renewed.
