BE IT ENACTED by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of Montserrat, and by the Authority of the same as follows: —

1 Short title

This Act may be cited as the Supplementary Appropriation (No. 6) Act, 2023.

2 Authorisation of expenditure

The various sums of money set out under the Schedule totalling Eighty Seven Thousand dollars (\$87,000), in addition to the sum of Sixty Five Million, Three Hundred and Eighty Thousand, Four Hundred dollars (\$65,380,400) granted by the Appropriation Act 2022 (No. 8 of 2022), the Supplementary Appropriation Act 2022 (No. 9 of 2022), the Supplementary Appropriation (No. 2) Act 2022 (No. 10 of 2022) and the Supplementary Appropriation (No. 5) Act (No. 11 of 2022) are declared to be charged upon and made payable from the Development Fund.

3 Withdrawals and payments

The Accountant General is authorised and required from time to time, upon the authority of warrants issued under the hand of the Minister of Finance, to withdraw and pay the sums appropriated for the purposes set out in the Schedule to the several services mentioned as the warrants may direct out of the Consolidated Fund without further order or formality.
