AN ORDINANCE TO REPEAL AND REPLACE THE TREASURY REGULATIONS (AFTER HOURS WORK) ORDINANCE, CAP. 226.

BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of Montserrat, and by the authority of the same as follows:—

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Customs (After Hours Work) Ordinance, 1975. Short Title.

2.(1) It shall be lawful for the Governor in Council to make, and when made, vary or revoke regulations for the entering and clearing of any vessel, and the landing and shipment of passengers and cargo, before or after the usual office hours, including the payment of fees and charges in connection therewith. Governor in Council may make Regulations.

(2) Regulations so made shall be laid before the Legislative Council as soon as convenient after being made, and shall be published in the Gazette:

Provided that until such regulations shall be made, the regulations contained in the Schedule to this Ordinance shall be in force.

3. The Treasury Regulations (After Hours Work) Ordinance is hereby repealed. Repeal.

SCHEDULE

S.2(2)

Regulations

1. **COMPTROLLER MAY GRANT PERMISSION TO ENTER OR CLEAR VESSELS.** The Comptroller of Customs and Excise may, upon application, grant permission to enter or clear any vessel before or after the usual office hours, upon being satisfied that all dues and other charges have been paid.

2. **PERMISSION FOR PASSENGERS OR CARGO TO BE LANDED OR CARGO SHIPPED.** The Comptroller of Customs and Excise may, upon application, allow passengers and cargo to be landed, or cargo to be shipped, before 8 a.m. and after 4.30 p.m. upon all fees being paid or upon payment thereof being guaranteed by the agent or master of the vessel.

3. **FEES.** The following fees shall be payable for the services provided for in regulations 1 and 2:—

- (a) For any permit to enter or clear any vessel before 8 a.m. or after 4.30 p.m., the sum of \$5.00;
- (b) For attendance on vessels before 8 a.m. or after 4.30 p.m. for the purpose of receiving cargo, passengers and baggage or receiving and shipping passengers or cargo, there shall be charged, for each officer so employed, the hourly rate of \$8.00 on weekdays, and \$10.50 on Sundays and Public Holidays:

Provided that for any services rendered under paragraph (b) of this regulation, there shall be a minimum charge for two hours in respect of each officer so employed.

4. **LANDING GOODS ELSEWHERE THAN AT PLYMOUTH.** On an application to land goods elsewhere than at Plymouth, the Comptroller of Customs and Excise may require a deposit to be made of such a sum as will cover the charges for the services and expenses of the officers in attendance.
