**A PROCLAMATION BY THE GOVERNOR

WHEREAS section 58(1) of the Montserrat Constitution Order (Cap. 1.01) provides that the sessions of the Legislative Assembly shall be held at such times and places as the Speaker may appoint by proclamation published in the *Gazette*;

AND WHEREAS section 58(1) of the Montserrat Constitution Order 2010 (Cap 1.01) provides that there shall be at least one session of the Legislative Assembly in every year;

AND WHEREAS the Governor, acting in accordance with the advice of the Premier, prorogued the Legislative Assembly on the 1st day of August, 2026;

NOW THEREFORE, I, MARJORIE SMITH, Speaker of the Legislative Assembly, appoint the 6th day of October, 2026 at 9:30 a.m., at the Cultural Centre in Little Bay as the time and place at which the first sitting of the next session of the Legislative Assembly shall be held.
